IMAC Lifetime Memberships

Any competitor that wishes to qualify for an IMAC Lifetime Membership must be an IMAC member in good standing for a minimum of 5 years at the date of request.

Lifetime Memberships must be requested by the member through the members respective Regional Director.

IMAC Lifetime Memberships are NOT transferable to another member.

There are 2 options based on the member's age.

- Member must be a good member in good standing for a minimum of 5 years. At that time the member will be eligible to request a lifetime membership for a flat fee of \$750.00
- Senior Option: Member must 55 Years or Older and be a good member in good standing for a minimum of 5 years. At that time the member will be eligible to request a lifetime membership for a flat fee of \$400

After payment is received the members IMAC number will be updated and the letter "L" will be placed before the members IMAC number.

For Example IMAC Number: 7272 would now be entered as L7272

All contests that the pilot flies from that point on must have their new number entered in SCORE etc.

It will be the Regional Directors duty to verify if the member has flown any contests in that same year prior to the member becoming a lifetime member. The Regional Director will update the members IMAC number on those contests prior to the updated number so IRPS is not affected.

The member will receive a new membership card with updated lifetime membership proudly shown within 30 days that approval is given and lifetime membership payment is received.

*Per Section 4- Suspension and Expulsion per Club Bylaws: Any member with a Lifetime Membership found in violation of Sec. 4 and an Expulsion is voted on by 2/3rds of the BOD then there is no refund of a Lifetime Membership Fee.
